Over the past 14 years, Technovation has engaged more than 130,000 underserved youth and 28,000 industry mentors, educators, and parents across 100+ countries through its two flagship programs:

<u>Technovation Girls</u> equips young women (ages 10-18) to become tech entrepreneurs and leaders. With the support of volunteer mentors, girls work in teams to code mobile apps that address real-world problems. You may have seen Technovation featured in the award-winning documentary, <u>CodeGirl</u>, or recent coverage about our latest season in <u>Fast Company</u> and <u>Forbes</u>.

Technovation Families brings together families, schools, and mentors to learn, play, and create with artificial intelligence. Through hands-on projects, children (ages 8-16) and adults learn and use AI tools to address real-world problems in their communities. Among others, the program has been featured in <u>The Wall Street Journal</u> and <u>Entrepreneur</u>.

Our vision is to inspire girls and families to be leaders and problem solvers in their lives and their community. It is an exciting time at Technovation. We impact children and adults around the world with high-quality programs and have built strong relationships with companies and foundations that provide us with program mentors and funding. 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Responsibilities:

Grant writing and research (70%)

- Research funder priorities and align our application to those priorities
- Write full grant proposals, letters of inquiry and gather supporting information to complete applications
- Research grant opportunities/funding prospects:

 - o Corporations
 - o Global NGOs
 - o Foundations
 - o Academic Institutions
 - o Individual Donors

Development support (30%)

- Maintain database of prospects, proposals and reports
- Prepare monthly summaries of activities and progress
- Lead preparation of reports with program staff
- Perform prospect and donor research
- Maintain timely correspondence with donors

You'll need:

- 5+ years of fundraising experience and proven portfolio of successful fundraising (working with organizational budgets >\$3M)
- Strong grant writing experience (preferably in the education sector)

- Strong organization skills to strengthen our fund development processes
