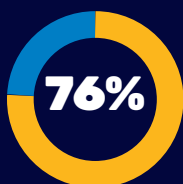

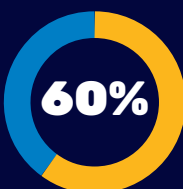
After completing Technovation's curriculum, participants show significant gains in their coding abilities, business and entrepreneurship skills, and problem-solving



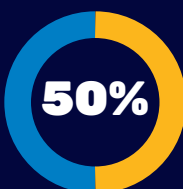
